

VIRUNGA VOCABULARY

SYLVICULTURE: THE SCIENCE OF PLANTING AND TAKING CARE OF TREES AND FORESTS.

VOLCAN: A VENT IN THE EARTH'S CRUST THROUGH WHICH LAVA, STEAM, ASHES, ETC., ARE EXPELLED, EITHER CONTINUOUSLY OR AT IRREGULAR INTERVALS.

BRACONNIER: A PERSON WHO TRESPASSES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, ESPECIALLY TO CATCH FISH OR GAME ILLEGALLY.

FAUNE: UNDOMESTICATED ANIMALS LIVING IN THE WILD, INCLUDING THOSE HUNTED FOR FOOD, SPORT, OR PROFIT.

RANGER: ONE OF A BODY OF ARMED GUARDS WHO PATROL A REGION.

GÉNOCIDE: THE DELIBERATE AND SYSTEMATIC EXTERMINATION OF A NATIONAL, RACIAL, POLITICAL, OR CULTURAL GROUP.

POLITICIENS: A PERSON WHO IS ACTIVE IN PARTY POLITICS.

CONSERVATIONNISTES: A PERSON WHO ADVOCATES OR PROMOTES CONSERVATION, ESPECIALLY OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

VÉTÉRINAIRE: A PERSON WHO PRACTICES VETERINARY MEDICINE OR SURGERY.

GORILLE SOIGNANT: A PERSON WHO CARES AND HELPS THE GORILLAS.

BIOLOGISTE: A BIOLOGIST, OR BIOLOGICAL SCIENTIST, IS A SCIENTIST WHO STUDIES LIVING ORGANISMS, OFTEN IN THE CONTEXT OF THEIR ENVIRONMENT.

INFIRMIÈRE: A PERSON FORMALLY EDUCATED AND TRAINED IN THE CARE OF THE SICK OR INFIRM.

DÉMOCRATIQUE: PERTAINING TO OR OF THE NATURE OF DEMOCRACY OR A DEMOCRACY.

PAYSAGE: A SECTION OR EXPANSE OF RURAL SCENERY, USUALLY EXTENSIVE, THAT CAN BE SEEN FROM A SINGLE VIEWPOINT.

HABITATS: THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT OF AN ORGANISM; PLACE THAT IS NATURAL FOR THE LIFE AND GROWTH OF AN ORGANISM

TOURISTES: A PERSON WHO IS TRAVELING, ESPECIALLY FOR PLEASURE.

PATRIMOINE: SOMETHING THAT COMES OR BELONGS TO ONE BY REASON OF BIRTH; AN INHERITED LOT OR PORTION

FONDS: A SUPPLY OF MONEY OR PECUNIARY RESOURCES, AS FOR SOME PURPOSE

LAC: A BODY OF FRESH OR SALT WATER OF CONSIDERABLE SIZE, SURROUNDED BY LAND.

montagnes: A NATURAL ELEVATION OF THE EARTH'S SURFACE RISING MORE OR LESS ABRUPTLY TO A SUMMIT, AND ATTAINING AN ALTITUDE GREATER THAN THAT OF A HILL, USUALLY GREATER THAN 2000 FEET (610 METERS).
